a) DOV/19/01537 | Erection of two-storey side and single storey rear extensions with balcony and balustrade (existing summer house, lean-to and rear porch to be demolished | 89 London Road, River, CT16 3AA –

The reason for the flat roof appears to be to give sufficient headroom for the additional bedrooms. However, it is believed that Dover District Council Planning Department adopted a policy deprecating two storey flat roof extensions some time ago. Furthermore, it is considered that the flank wall of the proposed extension – east elevation – could create a sense of overbearing when viewed from the adjacent property 89a London Road.

 b) DOV/19/01507 | Erection of a detached dwelling and change of use from offices to self-contained flat (existing garages to be demolished) | 7-9 Chilton Way, River, CT17 0QB –

The Parish Council has no objection to this application in principle. However, there is a concern that the loss of the existing garages, presumably for the use of the flats above the adjacent shops, may increase the demand for on-street car parking.
