**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER SEPTEMBER 2020**

**To allow a detailed bridge inspection to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Coombe Valley Road, Dover.**

**An overnight closures is planned for Thursday 3 September 2020 from 22:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours.**

**Coombe Valley Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the railway bridge.**

**The alternative route for all through traffic is via A256 London Road (plus Buckland Avenue and Cherry Tree Avenue in opposite direction due to one-way system), Crabble Hill, Crabble Road, Crabble Avenue, Hillside Road, Bunkers Hill Road, St Radigund's Road and Barwick Road back to Coombe Valley Road, and vice versa.**
