



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**A256 BUCKLAND AVENUE, DOVER**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow works to be carried out to replace a sewer frame and cover in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Buckland Avenue, Dover.

An overnight closure is currently planned for Thursday 24 September 2020 from 19:00 hours onwards, with the road re-opened by no later than 05:00 hours.

A256 Buckland Avenue will be closed at and including the junction with Whitfield Avenue.

*~ There will be no direct access into Dover from Crabble Hill and Whitfield Hill ~*

The alternative route for through traffic is via A256 Crabble Hill, London Road (River), Whitfield Hill, Whitfield Roundabout, A2 Trunk Road, Duke of York's Roundabout, Jubilee Way, A20 Townwall Street, A256 York Street, Priory Road, High Street and London Road

*Strictly for light vehicles only*, the remainder of A256 Buckland Avenue can be accessed via Old Park Road and Brookfield Avenue, but this route is only suitable for cars, due to narrow roads and tight turns at junctions.

Whitfield Avenue will be closed at its junction with A256 Buckland Avenue, with no access.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Whitfield Avenue will be suspended to allow essential access / exit from Brookfield Avenue direction.
