COOMBE VALLEY ROAD, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2020

To allow sewer jetting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Coombe Valley Road, Dover.

Overnight closures are planned from 20 October 2020 for up to 3 nights, from 20:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

Coombe Valley Road will be closed to the extent indicated, with no through access between the junctions with Edgar Road and MacDonald Road.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A256 London Road (plus Buckland Avenue and Cherry Tree Avenue in opposite direction due to one-way system), Crabble Hill, Crabble Road, Crabble Avenue, Hillside Road, Bunkers Hill Road, St Radigund's Road and Barwick Road back to Coombe Valley Road, and vice versa.

Local access to the remainder of Coombe Valley Road continues from either direction up to the point of closure.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Southern Water Permit LQ001SWAT10738655], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
