LOWER ROAD, RIVER, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER DECEMBER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to replace a sewer frame and cover in the carriageway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lower Road, River, Dover.

A closure is currently planned for Monday 21 December 2020 from 09:00 hours for up to 4 hours, with the possibility of a repeat closure the following day in the event of any difficulties.

Lower Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 86, with no through access between the junctions with Minnis Lane and Common Lane.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Minnis Lane, Lewisham Road and Common Lane.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Lower Road will be suspended between the junctions with Minnis Lane and Common Lane, to allow essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.
