CANTERBURY ROAD, LYDDEN, DOVER

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow a detailed bridge inspection to be safely carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Canterbury Road, Lydden, Dover.

An overnight closure is planned for Monday 12 October 2020, from 22:00 hours through until approximately 06:00 hours.

Canterbury Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the railway bridge at the sharp bends.

~ There will be no direct access between the Dover and Lydden during these works ~

The alternative route for through traffic is via London Road, A256 Whitfield Hill, Whitfield Roundabout, A2 Dover Road and Lydden Hill back to Canterbury Road.

Local access to the remainder of Canterbury Road / London Road continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.
